Orane Usage Rules and Procedures

NOTE: Orane Usage Rules and Procedures are currently under development. Therefore this document is not complete at this time. It will be revised, extended and updated often, so please check this website for the latest revision. Printed copies might be out of date very quickly.

Orane is RPSA's Columbia 27 ft sailboat. Orane Committee (OC) is responsible for all aspects of the sailboat, like Rules, Procedures and Usage. It's members are appointed by the RPSA board and it's recommendations are approved by the board.

Orane Users

The current RPSA members which paid the additional fee for the use of the keel boat can use *Orane*.

Orane users fall into two categories:

- **Skippers** – Only an OC approved skipper can take *Orane* out. The Skipper is in charge of all aspects of the trip, paying particular attention to the safety.
- **Crew**

Note that all *Orane* users should complete *Orane Skipper Application*. Crew should only fill-out the parts describing their boating experience. This information will be very helpful to skippers to know what level of boating skills they have on board.

Orane Skippers

There are several levels of Orane Skippers. Each level has its own requirements and restrictions. After reviewing the application, and if the applicant has the sufficient qualifications and experience, OC will assign appropriate Skipper Level. The following table explains the levels in detail.
